Built next to a 2nd Century fort on cliffs overlooking the sea and the Solway Coast, this award winning museum houses the largest collection of Roman altars from a single site in Britain, including altars carved in Maryport for the emperor Hadrian's friend Marcus Maenius Agrippa.

This unique collection of Roman sculpture and inscriptions, begun by John Senhouse of Netherhall in the reign of Elizabeth I, is the oldest antiquarian collection in Britain.
