



Ewes Cheese
Sheep milk is used to make over 80 types of delicious cheese. Try some in the village.

Can Sheep Swim?
They prefer not to, but can swim 'doggy-paddle' style when confronted with flooding.

Lake District Herdwick Sheep
The most hardy of all Britain's breeds of hill sheep, grazing on Lake District fells that rise to over 3,000 feet. They have grey faces, with arched nose and white ears. Their coarse wool makes warm clothes and is used for eco-friendly loft insulation!

Spotted Sheep
Jacob sheep take their name from the Biblical story of Jacob who chose only spotted sheep for his flock. Look out for their descendants in South Lakeland fields.

Miracle Lamb
In 2004 a lamb was born with "Allah" (the Arabic word for God) written in Arabic on its back.

Lamb of God
Christians traditionally refer to Jesus as the "Lamb of God"



How Many Stomachs?
Sheep are ruminants and have 4 different sections in their stomach to help them digest food.

Chewing the Cud - What Do Sheep Eat?
Sheep graze mainly on grass & clover. Farmers give them hay, silage and swedes in winter.

Counting Sheep
Worldwide there are over 1,000 different breeds of sheep. 16.1 million lambs are born in the UK every year. That's a lot of woolly jumpers!



How Long Do Sheep Live?
The average sheep lives for 10 - 12 years.

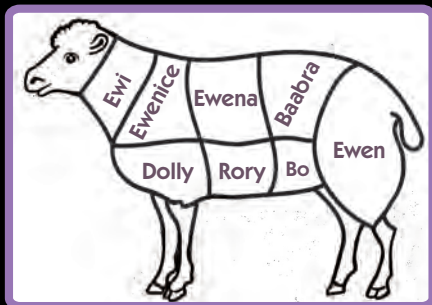

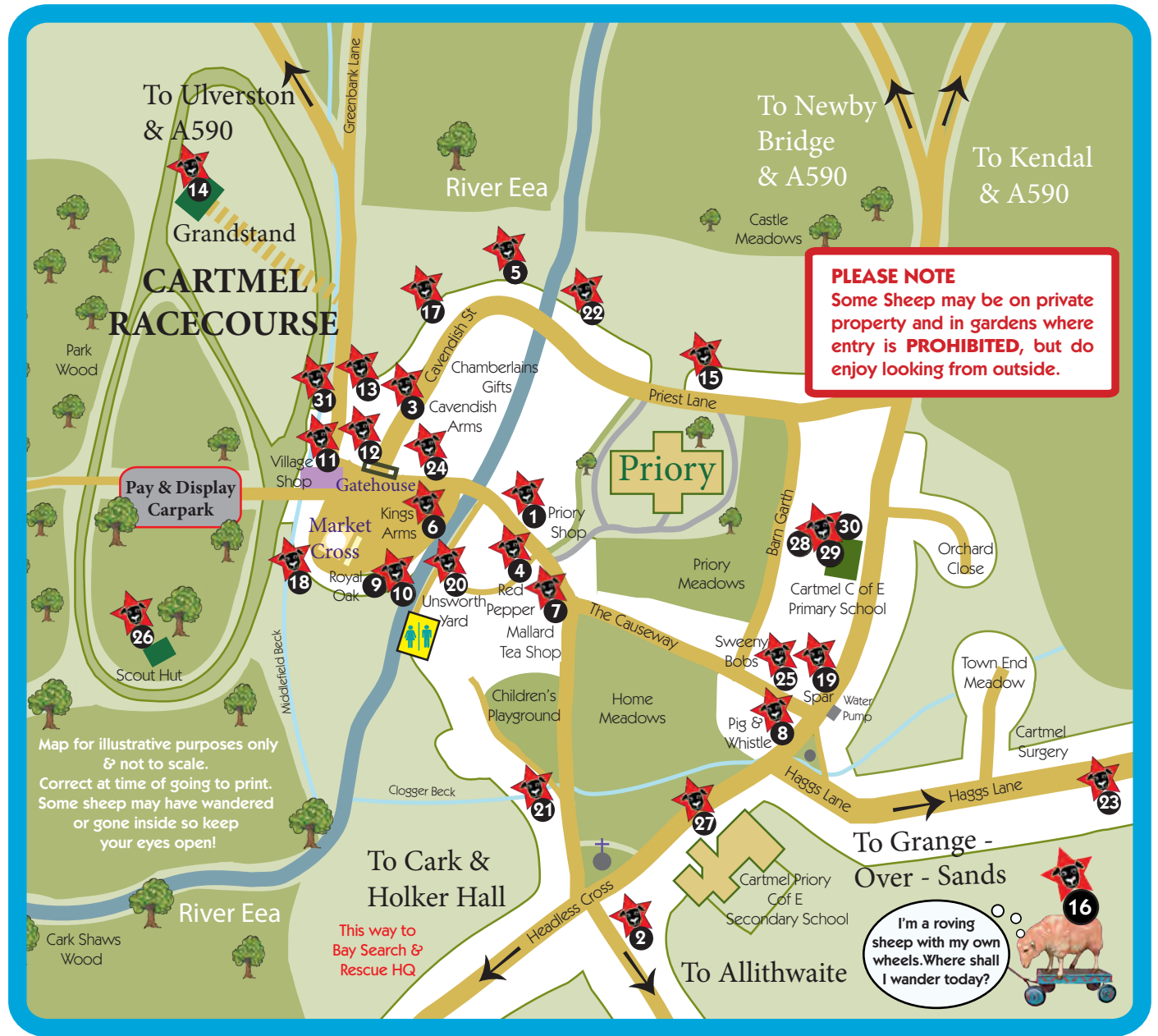

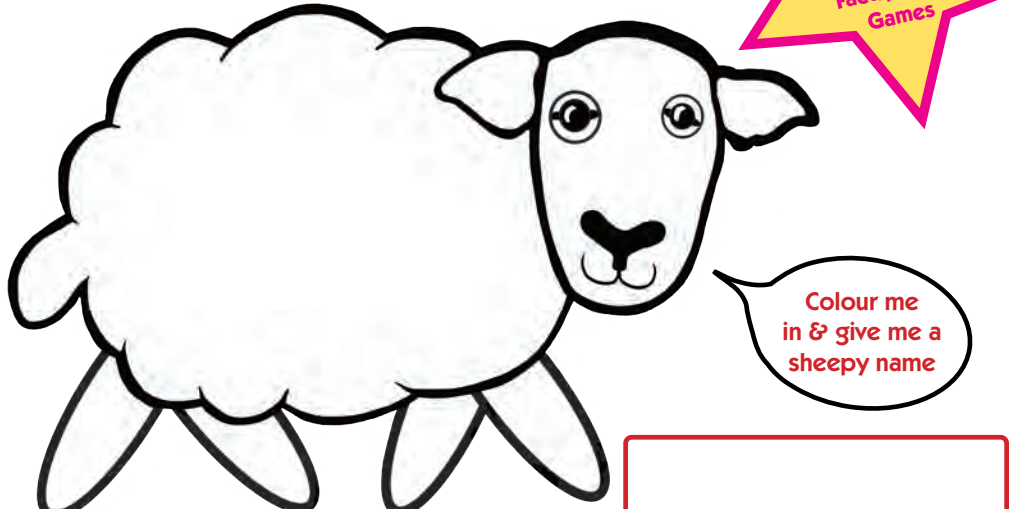
